- **Above mentioned guidelines will help your child to become a smart & an active learner.**



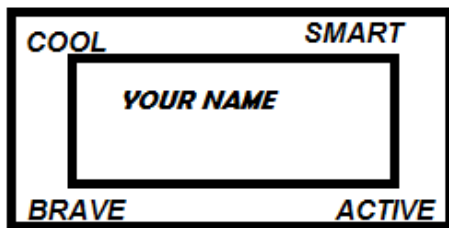
❖ FATHER'S DAY CELEBRATION :-
